Atonement for High Priest and his house	2. Bullock as a sin offering	4. Taken within veil with incense. Sprinkled 7 times upon Mercy Seat in eastward direction. Smearred on horns of altar of incense. Remainder poured out at base of altar of burnt offering.	16. Inner fat and inner organs	18. Taken outside camp and burnt	1. In preparation, High Priest washed his flesh, and put on linen garments. 3. Incense had to be burning in censer, with coals of fire taken from altar of burnt offering, so that it caused a cloud to cover the Mercy Seat.
Atonement for High Priest and his house	10. Ram as a burnt offering	11. Sprinkled on altar of burnt offering.	12. Entire animal except skin	—	—
Atonement for congregation	5. 2 Male Goats as a sin offering. High Priest cast lots.	6. Blood of one goat taken within veil with incense. Sprinkled 7 times upon Mercy Seat in eastward direction. Smearred on horns of altar of incense. Remainder poured out at base of altar of burnt offering.	17. Inner fat and inner organs	18. Taken outside camp and burnt	7. Atonement was also made for Tabernacle and altar of burnt offering. 8. High Priest laid his hands on second goat and confessed sins of people. A fit man led it away into the wilderness where it was set free. 9. High Priest took off linen garments and left them inside Tabernacle. He washed his flesh and put on priestly garments.
